#### 118 AWARDS IN 2023

In 2023, the GCEE team accomplished a remarkable milestone by clinching 118 awards, marking yet another significant achievement in the organisation's two-decade journey. #### **IMC AWARDS**

The Indian Merchants' Chamber (IMC) has a distinguished accolade in Ramakrishna Bajaj National Quality Award (RBNQA) - that encourages quality awareness in business and recognises its value in worldwide effectiveness.

With requirements the same as the Malcolm Baldrige criteria in the United States, IMC RBNQA has become a symbol of excellence over the years in India for raising awareness that excellence is the only attribute that can help a company beat the competition.

It has established a clear, tough and universal standard for measuring excellence, and integrated all of the concepts for achieving performance excellence while emphasising high integrity and quality leadership.

GIIS has won 74 of these awards and has been measured for its organisational performance using the internationally benchmarked Business Excellence framework after completing the IMC RBNQA Business Excellence project.

#### **IMC RBNQA - PERFORMANCE EXCELLENCE**

GSF has won 23 awards for Excellence in Performance since it made a conscious decision to develop its own quality standards. The process of compiling the Application Report for the IMC RBNQA allowed us to reflect on our previous essential business processes while also planning and executing our new strategies.

Our team members' training, evaluation procedure, and feedback session were all unique and rigorous. It is strongly recommended for organisations on a quest for excellence and a desire to compete with the best in order to achieve true "World Class" status.

#### IMC - MQH (MAKE QUALITY HAPPEN)

The biennial Make Quality Happen Best Practices Competition, hosted by the IMC RBNQA Trust, honours outstanding industrial practices in India. This year it was held from November 21 to November 24, 2023, in which GSF put on a tremendous performance, winning 5 trophies.

At this platform, our campuses have presented a number of best practice initiatives in the areas of innovation, technology, being future-ready, emotional well-being, curriculum, and so on.



#### **IMC MM (MILESTONE MERIT)**

The Milestone Merits is an award program established by the IMC Ramkrishna Bajaj National Quality Award Trust to acknowledge organisations that fulfil the requirements of the IMC RBNQA model. If a substantial portion of the criteria is met, the award is presented. Our GSF campus teams were successful in winning all four categories in 2023, for Leadership (Witty International School, Chikuwadi, Mumbai), Customer Focus (Glendale Academy, Hyderabad), Operations (GIIS Abu Dhabi) and Workforce (OWIS Whitefield). Despite facing fierce competition from other industries, we emerged victorious.

GSF has earned 16 awards in this category till date, including the Milestone Merit award for all four campuses in 2023.





#### **ELETS**



#### **BLOSSOMS & BEYOND**

Our campuses are vibrant ecosystems reflecting the beauty of nature. Each plant, from blossoms to towering trees, tells a story of resilience and coexistence. Our project goes beyond visual beauty, delving into ecological narratives to emphasise biodiversity's crucial role in fostering resilience and harmony. We aim to deepen understanding of ecosystem relationships, appreciating interconnectedness. Our campuses contribute to a broader ecological narrative, extending beyond classrooms.

#### **EDU TRUST**

Edu Trust is a voluntary quality assurance scheme for Private Education Institutions (PEIs) in Singapore. This certification recognises PEIs that consistently maintain a high level of quality in all aspects of education and make continual improvements that lead to positive student outcomes. The Edu Trust certification requires is well-structured policies and processes that meet the various criterion stipulated in the Edu Trust Guidance Document from the Committee for Private Education (CPE) Singapore. Both the Global Indian International School (GIIS) and One World International School (OWIS) Singapore are registered as PEIs by the CPE and have been granted 4-year certificates. PEIs need to provide a higher standard of educational services in order to be Edu Trust certified.

The Skills Future Singapore (SSG) functions independently as the regulatory authority of the private education industry in Singapore and is responsible for all decisions under the Edu Trust Certification Scheme. SSG aims to raise the standards of the industry to ensure PEIs provide a better standard of educational services and good student/ graduate outcomes. Also, student fees are insured through the Fee Protections Scheme (FPS).

Edu Trust certification is done through an assessment of how well its systems and processes address and align with SSG/CPE requirements. The SSG/CPE issues an Edu Trust Guidance Document (GD) for PEIs to focus on putting in place effective and efficient systems and processes, producing outcomes leading to high quality education services. Guidance Document version 4 (GD4) is the current version.

The key changes in GD4 are re-organisation of requirements, emphasis on existing requirements, new requirements, and focus beyond student and graduate outcomes. Terms and Conditions governing the Edu Trust Certification Scheme is:

to provide a legally binding set of obligations and governing rules to members of the scheme

to protect the integrity of the Edu Trust scheme

to prevent abuses

#### AUDIT MANAGEMENT THROUGH QUALITY MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE

The Global Centre for Education Excellence (GCEE) commenced the master certification process for all campuses across various brands in 2019. This encompassed conducting yearly Internal and External Audits across all campuses, along with monitoring and documenting all findings resulting from these audits.

Managing and resolving all findings began to pose challenges as the number of brands and campuses increased exponentially. As a result, we obtained software and tailored it to meet the specific requirements for managing all ISO audits.

We were able to effectively oversee all audits and generate Corrective Action Requests (CARs) for all findings stemming from these audits. We successfully analysed the findings, delved into the root causes, and derived effective corrective and preventive actions accordingly. We also maintained a record of all audits and their findings, enabling us to demonstrate best practices to external forums and auditors.

#### ISO CERTIFICATION




